International Energy Group – Electricity Generation Licence

The Committee for the Environment and Infrastructure is aware of CICRA's notice of a proposed decision to grant an electricity generation licence to the International Energy Group (IEG). We understand that is also a very short window of opportunity to respond and make representations on this issue. The Committee believes that the awarding of a licence is a significant issue which needs a full and detailed consideration of all the issues.

The Committee is intending as set out in the States Policy and Resource Plan to update the 2012 Energy Resource Plan which should inform and guide CICRA in performing its statutory duties. Market liberalisation at this stage might appear premature. The Committee therefore encourages CICRA to allow a longer period of representation so that it can fully appreciate the wider energy policy context.
