**'Pan-Channel Island Consultation on Spectrum Awards in the 2.6 GHz Band**

Please find Jersey Airtel & Guernsey Airtel's joint response to the question raised by CICRA in the above consultation dated 04<sup>th</sup> April 2018:

**Question 1:** Respondents are invited to comment on the allocation of additional spectrum to Airtel, JT and Sure, taking their allocation to 20 MHz per operator, and the re-organisation of this band.

**Airtel's Response:** We welcome the CICRA initiative regarding the allocation of additional spectrum in Jersey and Guernsey. Airtel is the only telecom services provider which is offering a viable and real wireless broadband option to Channel Island customers using the 4G spectrum. To continue the growth story, we need an additional 10MHz in 2.6GHz band which will help us in building high capacity sites. Airtel is open to reorganization of its present holding in 2.6Ghz so as to achieve contiguity. This will help Airtel in targeting hotspot areas and continue to promote competition in home broadband.
