Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority 2nd Floor Salisbury House, 1-9 Union Street, St Helier, Jersey, JE2 3RF Tel: +44 (0)1534 514990 Web: www.cicra.je In this Statutory Notice, the Guernsey Competition and Regulatory Authority (**GCRA**) proposes to modify, pursuant to Section 8 of the <u>Telecommunications</u> (Bailiwick of Guernsey) <u>Law 2001</u> (the **Law**), the Telecommunications Licence (the Licence) issued to LP Telecoms Limited (LP Telecoms). The proposed modification is to Condition 1 and would shorten the term of the licence so that it expires on 22 December 2017. The reasons for this are set out below.

Proposed Licence Revision

The GCRA issued the Licence to LP Telecoms under Section 4 of the Law on 3 August 2011. Condition 1 of the Licence states, in relevant part, that:

Term: means, subject to Condition 11, a period of fifteen years from the Licence Commencement Date

LP Telecoms has informed the GCRA that it wishes the Licence to be terminated. For that reason, the GCRA is proposing to modify the Term of the Licence so as to bring it to an end on 22 December 2017. To achieve this, the GCRA is proposing to modify condition 1 of the Licence. The proposed new condition would state, in relevant part, that:

Term: means the period between the Licence Commencement Date and ending on 22 December 2017

The legal ground for this notice and the proposed modifications set out herein is Section 8 (concerning modification of licence conditions) of the Law.

The proposed licence modification will take place on 22 December 2017 unless the GCRA receives written representations or objections about the proposal prior to that date, in which case these will be considered before making the modification or deciding not to make the modification.
